Inability to operate at systems and policy level

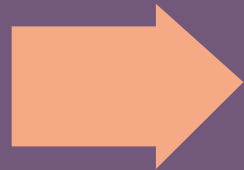


# Vision for an integrated community-based seniors serving sector

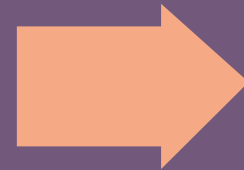
By building the infrastructure that connects the sector's organizations, the community-based sector can collaborate and integrate at a systems level



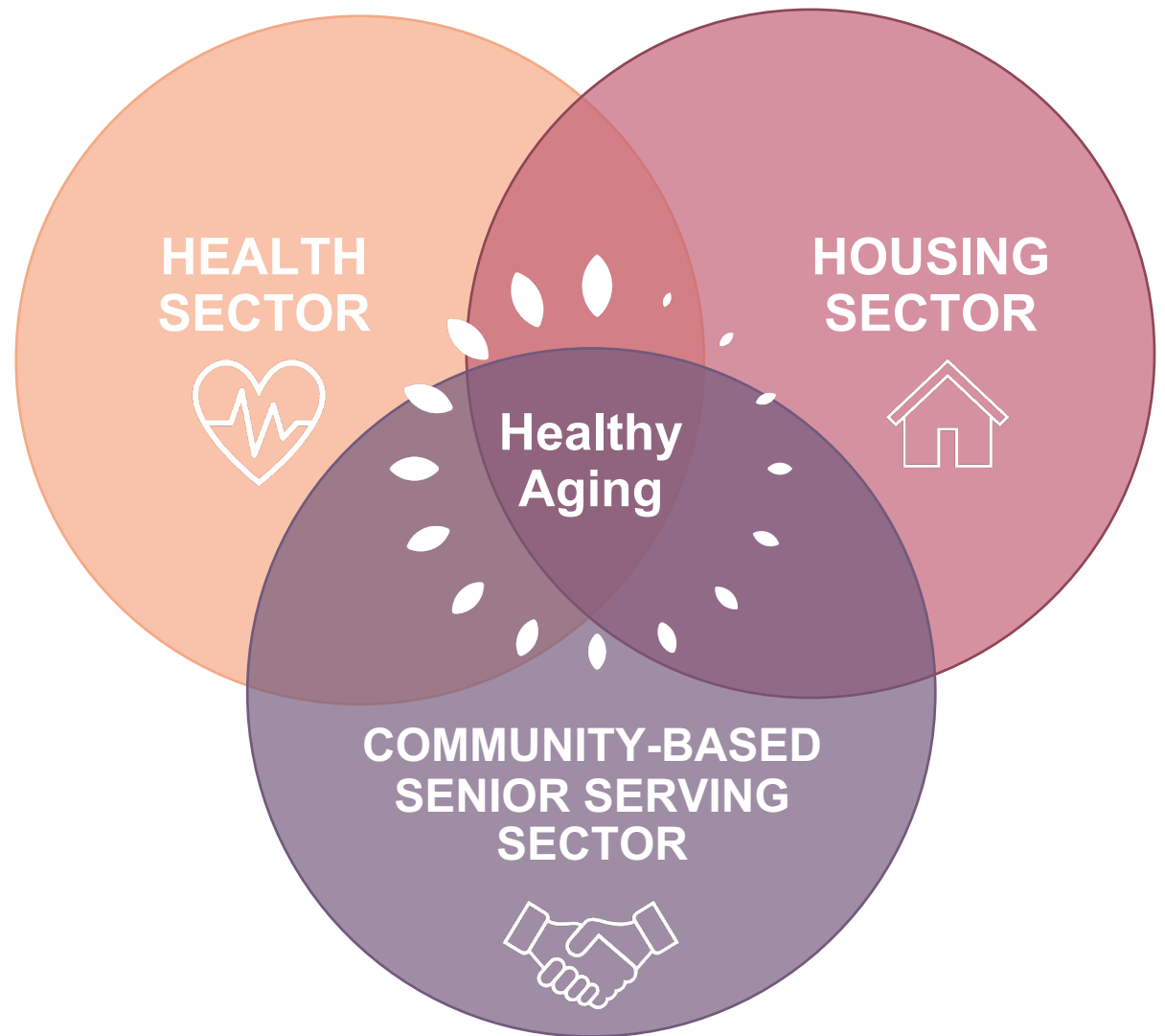
